Boordawan – See You Later

This supervised gathering point helps ensure that every student is accounted for before they are collected or depart for home.

- ★ Collect students from the designated pick-up area promptly at the end of the school day.

- ★ Parents are invited to sit on the benches inside the Undercover Area while waiting for their child.
- ★ Follow staff directions and use the designated pick-up and parking areas to ensure the safety of all students.
- ★ Notify the school of any changes to normal collection arrangements before the end of the school day, via phone call or email to the front office.
- ★ Remind students to remain in the supervised Undercover Area until they are collected or given permission to leave.
- ★ Parents and students are to depart the school grounds by **3:15pm**.
- ★ Bus students are to be supervised by the Bus Duty staff member until 3:30pm.

Additional Play Time at End of Day - 9:00pm
To improve the opportunities for student physical activity, social interaction and self-regulation, we have been trialling additional play time at recess **10:30am – 11:00am.**

Students then eat under the supervision of the teacher in class, **11:00am – 11:15am**. Longer break periods support student wellbeing by allowing sufficient time to engage in active play, develop positive peer relationships and return to class settled and ready to learn. The trial has also reduced congestion in play areas, supported positive

Lunch eating time is structured in the same manner, with students playing from **12:40pm – 1:10pm pack up/toilet at 1:10pm. Eating time in class 1:15pm – 1:30pm.**

To meet the Department of Education's requirement to provide instructional time while maintaining the enhanced recess and lunch breaks, the school's home time will be adjusted to **3.00 pm, as approved by the School Board.**

This change restores the instructional time required under Departmental policy without reducing the additional opportunities for play, physical activity and social interaction that have been shown to positively support student wellbeing and engagement.
