E-scooters

Under WA road safety laws, only people aged 16 and over are permitted to use eRideables or eBikes with the motor engaged.

As a reminder, as of Term 1, 2026 (from 2 February), students under 16 years old are not allowed to use eRideables or eBikes on school grounds.
