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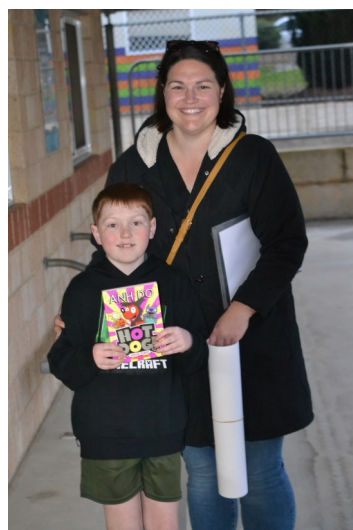

The Year 6 class will be participating in a youth mental health forum at the YMCA Narrogin Regional Leisure Centre on Friday 8 September. There will also be an opportunity for our students to network with students from other schools within our Wheatbelt Region.
