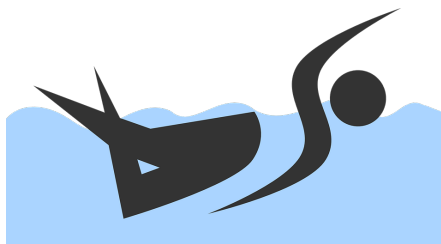


Senior Aussie of the Month-Zara Ninyyette
