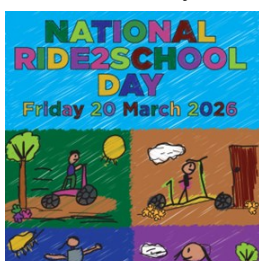


Ride 2 School Day
