Thank you to Miss Brosnon and her students for sharing their knowledge and giving our ENPS students an insight to the fun they will have in high school.














#### **Book Awards**

#### **ENE Bee Assembly**


Congratulations to our students who had their names drawn at our Monday Assembly. These students each had the chance to select a reward from the ENE Bee Chart.
